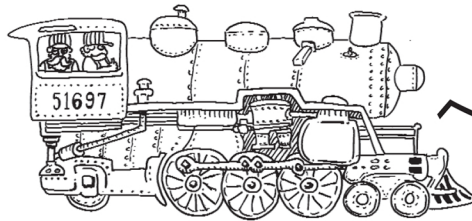

HALF WAY THERE . . .

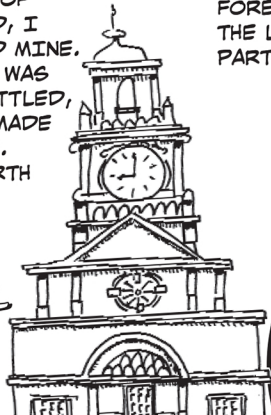

FACT: 1848 JAMES MARSHALL FOUND A PEA-SHAPED PEBBLE OF YELLOW METAL. "BOYS, BY GOD, I BELIEVE I HAVE FOUND A GOLD MINE. "THE CALIFORNIA GOLD RUSH" WAS UNDERWAY. WHEN THE DUST SETTLED, MORE THAN 300,000 PEOPLE MADE THEIR WAY TO SAN FRANCISCO. MORE THAN \$170 MILLION WORTH OF BILLION.

FACT: THE LIBERTY BELL ARRIVED IN PHILADELPHIA FROM BRITAIN AND WAS INSTALLED IN INDEPENDENCE HALL IN 1753 AND PROBABLY THE BELL WAS MELTED DOWN TWICE AND WAS RUNG MAYBE ONCE OR TWICE FOREVER IN 1846 ON WASHINGTON'S BIRTHDAY WHERE IT PERSISTED. THE LIBERTY BELL WAS NEVER RUNG ON JULY 4TH 1776 THOUGH IT IS PART OF AMERICAN FOLKLORE.
